The 62 metre yacht, built by Viareggio Superyachts, features leather hide floors, crystal chandeliers and multiple wood finishes. Colours, from bitter chocolate to gold, combine to create a classical scheme reflecting the grandeur of the early twentieth century and the height of the seafaring trade. A host of technologies can respond to natural occurring phenomena such as light, temperature and movement. These are all incorporated into different areas of the yacht.
